Safety Program of the Year was given to one outstanding safety program across the state. We received this award for our work with the Water Safety Weeks with our local 2nd graders. Awards were presented at the 2015 Texas Public Pool Conference.



Swim Lessons

Time specified in chart below

Level I - Participants start by getting familiar with the water. They practice entering and exiting the water, learning to float on their front and back, opening eyes under the water, as well as exploring underwater.

Level II - Participants learn to tread water, glide on their front and back, explore swimming on their sides, swimming on front and back using combined strokes, as well as rhythmic breathing.

Level III - Participants learn rotary breathing, begin the butterfly stroke, diving from kneeling and standing positions, front crawl, and back crawl and the survival float.

Level IV - Participants are introduced to the breaststroke, elementary backstroke, open turns, compact jump, diving and throwing assists, and a variety of safety issues.
