Item	Description	Preparation	Item
Glass bottles & jars	All clear, brown and green glass bottles & jars.	Rinse containers. Labels OK	Dishes, cookware, mirror glass, light bulbs, blue glass, ceramics and porcelain
Plastic bottles	All #1 and #2 plastics. #3 thru #7 plastic containers.	Rinse containers. Labels OK.	Plastic bags. Plastic toys.
Metal cans	Steel or tin food cans; clean foil products, empty aerosol cans; air-dried paint cans; small tin and metal items.	Rinse containers. Labels OK.	No large metal items.
Newspaper	Newspapers including inserts inside the paper.	Keep clean & dry. Remove any plastic bags or rubber bands.	Product samples; packing paper.
Mixed paper	Junk mail; magazines and catalogs with shiny (glossy) paper. Phone books, paperback books, office paper, envelopes, etc.	Keep clean & dry. Remove any plastic bags or rubber bands.	
Batteries	Lead-acid batteries (auto, boat, tractor, motorcycle, etc). Dry cell batteries (AA, AAA, C, D, etc)	Empty into designated blue drums.	No Lithium or Lithium-ion (Li-On) batteries.
Aluminum	Aluminum soda or beverage cans.	Place in bag or bin.	No aluminum food cans or pet food cans (tuna fish cans, dog/cat food cans). These may be placed in the METAL container.
Cardboard	Corrugated cardboard; food boxes; kraft paper bags, etc.	Remove plastic wrapping	No packing material, Styrofoam items (peanuts, blocks, etc.)
Motor oil & filters	Used motor oil and filters.	Place in jugs or containers.	
Cell phones	Used cell phones	Take out of case and do not include chargers.	
Cooking oil	Used liquified cooking oil. (Canola, vegetable, corn, peanut, olive.)	Allow the oil to cool and pour into plastic or metal container with tight-fitting lid and handle.	Animal fats or heavy solids.
