Hazard	Floods and Hurricanes
Background	Due to heavy rains and flash flood events within Washington County over the past several years erosion has become an issue within many watersheds. The City of Brenham owns and maintains multiple critical facilities and lift stations that are located in or near special flood hazard areas or flood prone areas within the City. These facilities become inundated with storm water cause infiltration into the sanitary system or compromising services to the citizens.
